

Full-paper: general guidelines for authors

STEP 1 – Download the template

The templates are available from IEEE website: https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates.html

Microsoft Word A4 (DOC) is recommended.

STEP 2 – Complete your paper

Please do not forget to include the necessary data as authors' information/affiliation, references, **keywords**, etc. Do NOT add page numbers to the manuscript.

STEP 3 – Convert your document into IEEE-compatible PDF

Log in to the IEEE PDF eXpress® site.

First-time users should do the following:

- 1. Create Account
- 2. Enter the following:
 - · 69923X for the Conference ID
 - · your email address
 - · a password
- 3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed, and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

Previous users of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.

STEP 3 – Upload your submission through Microsoft Conference Management Toolkit

Your paper should be uploaded through Microsoft Conference Management Toolkit (https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ME2026) before September 10, 2026.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Only original research meeting all technical requirements will be included in the proceedings. **All accepted and published papers have to be presented during the conference** by one of the authors. Accepted papers will be submitted for possible inclusion into IEEE Xplore, subject to meeting IEEE Xplore's scope and quality requirements. Please note that papers not presented during the conference will not be indexed in the databases.

Plagiarism, duplicate submissions, or content reuse will lead to automatic rejection.
